RULES OF THE STATE LIBRARY.

HOURS.

The Ohio State Library is open every day, except Sunday and the usual holidays.

During the session of the Legislature, from nine o'clock A.M. till twelve M.; from two P.M. to five P.M.; and from seven P.M. to nine P.M.

After the adjournment of the Legislature, from nine A.M. till twelve M., and from two to five P.M.

REGULATIONS.

All persons are permitted to visit the Library and examine and read the books and magazines.

Those who are entitled to take out books are—

By law :

Members and officers and ex-members of the Legislature ;

State officers and clerks in the several departments ;

The Judges of the Supreme Court and Courts of Common Pleas ;

Superintendents in the benevolent and other State institutions.

By resolution :

Resident ministers in the city of Columbus have, by a resolution of the General Assembly, free use of the Library, in accordance with the rules, who are at the time pastors of congregations, and who apply in person for books for their own special use.

The privilege of drawing books from the Library is also extended to the officers and teachers in the benevolent institutions of the State ; officers and teachers of the Ohio Agricultural College ; officers of the Ohio Penitentiary ; ex-officers of the State ; ex-officers of the General Assembly, and to the widows of deceased ex-members of the General Assembly and ex-State officers.

RESTRICTIONS.

Not more than two books can be taken by any person at one time within two weeks.

Books must be returned within two weeks.

Books of reference, and other books of peculiar value, are kept from circulation.

A public officer, or any other person having a right to take out books, who gives any other individual an order for books to be used by another not having such right, forfeits his own right to draw books.

Books lost or damaged must be replaced or paid for.

Copying from Library books must be done with pencil.

Loud talking forbidden.

Smoking prohibited.

LIBRARY COMMISSIONERS' REPORT.

1876.

To the General Assembly of Ohio:

At the date of the last annual report of this Library Board the work of remodeling the ceiling of the main department, which was intended to result in better light and healthier ventilation, had not been completed, and the entire interior was virtually inaccessible to the public. The work since then has been perfected, and in such an artistic manner as to meet with the unqualified approval of the Board, as well as to challenge the admiration of all visitors, citizens, and strangers. The Ohio State Library may now justly be claimed as the pride of the people of the State, and at the head of all the State libraries in the Union.

The appropriation of two hundred dollars for that purpose covered all the expenses of dusting and thoroughly cleaning every book in the main Library and most of those deposited in the document rooms; the cleanly condition of the entire interior, therefore, is regarded as the result of a judicious expenditure.

The system which was adopted in preparing the last catalogue for publication being regarded by the most critical judges as the simplest and best of all that have been in use among the leading libraries of the country, it has been considered expedient to continue the system as a preparatory labor for future use, when it may be deemed advisable in the interests of the Library to issue a new edition of the present very complete volume. This special labor is made one of the particular duties of the Assistant Librarian, Miss M. C. Harbaugh, and to which she is intelligently and methodically attending.

The literary press of the country has been peculiarly prolific during the past year of this Centennial era in the issue of new works of a standard character, quite a number of which, in accordance with the wise policy that has long been observed in this Library, have been added to its appropriate shelves. It is to the character and quality of these

new editions of books that the critical eye of members is specially directed, and as the basis of their judgment regarding the manner in which the public funds have been expended. The last report represented as then being registered in the general and law department 40,068 volumes, since which publication there have been 876 volumes added.
