REPORT OF THE BOARD OF LIBRARY COMMISSIONERS.

COLUMBUS, OHIO, November 15, 1904.

To His Excellency, MYRON T. HERRICK, Governor of Ohio.

SIR:—We have the honor to submit the fifty-ninth annual report of the Board of Library Commissioners, which is the ninth under the library act of 1896.

The report of the Librarian, which we are pleased herewith to transmit, summarizes the work of the past year, and shows continued progress in the different departments of the State Library. Exclusive of the Sherman collection over 7,000 books have been added since our last report. Before the end of another year the number of volumes actually on the shelves of the library will have exceeded 100,000. The accelerated growth is shown by the fact that, although established in 1817, eighty-seven years ago, the Library has more than doubled in number of volumes since the Commission took charge under the law of 1896. This condition is not pointed out as extraordinary or phenomenal; it is simply in line with the tendencies of the times and the growth of other libraries; the public demands more books covering a constantly widening range of subjects.

In this connection it may not be out of place to call attention to the character of recent accessions. Outside of the Traveling Library Department, fiction is not now purchased except occasionally in standard sets for reference purposes. This is a continuation of the policy previously adopted by the Board. Especial attention has been given to the collection of material relating to the history of Ohio, general and local. A very satisfactory proportion of the increase noted has been of this character. It is increasingly difficult, as the years pass, to collect newspaper and periodical literature issued in Ohio during the first half of the last century; and yet within the past six years there have been added five times as many newspapers bearing date prior to 1825 as in all the preceding history of the Library. It is the hope of the Board to improve the housing of this valuable collection in the near future. Of the new books purchased an increasing proportion is of history and reference works.

The purchases for the Traveling Library Department cover a wider range to meet the varied demands of patronizing organizations. College students and woman's clubs often ask for special works that would not interest the general reader. Granges and rural study clubs prefer books of a more popular character. To the schools juvenile literature is fre-

quently sent. It has been the constant aim to supply all with books that have the stamp of approval of competent critics.

The work done since our last report by the Traveling Library Department shows that it enjoys the continued favor of the public. Within the past year 966 traveling libraries, aggregating 30,935 volumes, have been sent to 647 different communities of the state. This is a substantial increase in libraries and volumes, while ninety-four more communities were reached than last year. These statistics indicate a more general circulation of traveling libraries than exhibited in any previous report. Ohio surpasses all other states in the number and distribution of traveling libraries.

The Legislature at its last session made provision for the erection of rooms connecting the two departments of the Library, and authorized the Governor, Adjutant General and President of the Board of Library Commissioners to carry out the provisions of the act. After advertising for bids the contract was awarded to the lowest bidder, John W. Horlocker, of Columbus, O. The work is now well under way. Shelving will soon be installed and ready to receive books and newspaper files that have been stored on the floor, in boxes and other places difficult of access. Additional shelving will also be provided for the Traveling Library Department. These improvements will afford temporary relief, but the time is not far distant when more ample quarters must be provided.

The Library has received a gift of about 5,000 volumes from the Sherman family. These were a part of the private library of the late Hon. John Sherman, who for many years served Ohio with distinguished ability. The collection consists chiefly of U. S. government documents, substantially bound. There are also several volumes on finance and bound pamphlets on a variety of subjects and covering the period of Senator Sherman's public service. For this donation the State is under obligations to the Sherman heirs, and especially to Senator Sherman's nephew, P. Tecumseh Sherman, of New York City.

In closing this brief report we wish again to commend most heartily the work of the State Librarian and the members of the Library staff, who have rendered faithful and efficient service. At the close of no previous year has the condition of the Library been more satisfactory or the outlook for the future more promising.

STATE LIBRARIAN'S REPORT.

COLUMBUS, OHIO, November 15, 1904.

To the Board of Library Commissioners.

GENTLEMEN:—I have the honor to submit to you the report of the State Librarian for the year ending November 15, 1904. Within the past year additions have been made as follows:

The number of volumes in the State Library at the close of last year was 90,228. This, with the net increase for the year, makes a total of 97,531 volumes.

The foregoing summary does not include the government documents, numbering about 5,000 volumes, presented by the Sherman family. These might have been added, thus making a total of over 100,000. They have been omitted, however, because they will, for the most part, be substituted for volumes now in the Library.

The following additions, received within the past year, are worthy of special note:

MISSOURI STATE DOCUMENTS.

Among the states from which, until recently, it has been practically impossible to get documents in exchange for those sent out regularly by this department is Missouri. Through the courtesy of F. A. Sampson, Secretary of the State Historical Society of Missouri, about 150 volumes, including House and Senate journals and department reports, have been received. It is hoped that satisfactory arrangements may be made for a regular exchange with that state.

THE GENTLEMAN'S MAGAZINE.

The Gentleman's Magazine, covering the period included in Poole's Index, has been purchased. The earlier volumes, from 1731-1831, have been sent to the Library for examination, and will probably be added

before the next report. It will be possible, at comparatively small cost, to complete the long file of this periodical.

THE CONFEDERATE VETERAN.

In 1893 was commenced the publication of *The Confederate Veteran*, a monthly magazine that officially represents a number of Southern Confederate organizations. Full sets are now difficult to collect. Through the kindly interest of the editor, S. A. Cunningham, Esq., a file that lacks only one year of being complete has been placed in the Library at the regular subscription price.

AGRICULTURAL ENQUIRIES ON PLASTER OF PARIS.

A book with this title, by Richard Peters, published at Philadelphia in 1797, was presented by Miss Josephine Klippart. It is dedicated to "George Washington, President of the United States," at whose request it was written. In an autograph note the author presents this particular copy to Dr. Joseph Priestly, a newspaper sketch of whom is also included.

GENEALOGY OF THE SHERMAN FAMILY.

A manuscript copy of the *Genealogy of the Sherman family*, compiled by the late Orrin D. Bradford, has been presented by his wife. This is a very important addition to the collection of histories of Ohio families.

BOOKS FROM THE LIBRARY OF HON. JOHN SHERMAN.

About one year ago a representative of the Sherman family intimated that if acceptable to the State a tender might be made of a large portion of the private library of the late Hon. John Sherman. Lists were submitted, and the Board of Library Commissioners signified a willingness to accept the books. They were promptly forwarded, the donors generously paying all expense of packing and shipping.

Most of these books are U. S. government documents; many of them are substantially bound in calf and morocco; all were in excellent condition when they arrived.

It is needless to say that in the main they duplicate material already in the Library. Many belong to the series usually designated as the "Congressional Set." The set already in the Library, while almost complete, is in bad condition because of decayed and broken bindings. Especially is this true of the older volumes. A few of these had been rebound, and arrangements had been made gradually to rebind about two-thirds of the entire set of over 4,000 volumes. When the Sherman collection arrived it was at once decided to insert in each volume a special plate indicating the source of the gift, and to substitute for the old set the new set in good bindings. By doing this the State saves a bill for

binding amounting to about \$2,000, and secures a fine array of volumes that bear evidence that they once belonged to the private library of a distinguished Ohioan who served his State long and well.

This noteworthy gift is not made up exclusively of government documents, however. It includes several volumes of bound pamphlets which will be found among the accessions of the past year. The contents of these have not been thoroughly analyzed. Most of them have indexes in Senator Sherman's handwriting. Many of the pamphlets are rare and valuable. They will probably be placed in special cases, out of respect to the memory of their former owner.

RARE BOOKS AND MANUSCRIPTS COPIED.

A few out of print books that should be in the Library command very high prices. Winthrop Sargent's *Journal of St. Clair's expedition against the Indians* has sold for more than \$100 a copy. As the tragic history it records occurred within the present limits of Ohio, a copy should be in the State Library. This need has been supplied by a typewritten copy of the original. In like manner complete copies of the personal journal of Sargent, 1793-95, and a number of other valuable narratives have been added to the Library. In this connection grateful recognition is due W. Butler Duncan, Esq., of New York City, and his wife, granddaughter of Winthrop Sargent, for many courtesies and valuable assistance in collecting material bearing upon the early history of the Northwest Territory. Mr. Duncan has presented copies of rare letters in his possession. Original manuscripts give information "at first hand," but when they cannot be had typewritten or printed copies, properly authenticated, answer about every practical purpose.

EXCHANGE OF DUPLICATE MAGAZINES.

The list of duplicate magazines, mention of which was made in the last report, is in press, and will soon be ready for distribution. Considerable interest has been manifested in this publication, and it is hoped that it will enable libraries of the State, through a system of exchanges, to improve the files of their periodicals.

LIST OF OHIO WRITERS.

Work has materially progressed in the compilation of a list of Ohio writers and their works. It will probably be published within the coming year.

BUYING LISTS.

The buying lists issued by the Free Library Commission of Wisconsin, and endorsed by the Commissions of other states, including Ohio, are valuable aids in the selection and purchase of books. The recent

issues have been purchased, and will be mailed free to the public libraries of the State.

CATALOGUING.

It has been truly observed that the value of a volume or a set of volumes may be multiplied by the addition of a good index. In greater measure may the practical utility of a library be enhanced by a good catalogue. Much improvement has been made within the past year in the catalogue of the State Library. As far as possible the printed cards of the Library of Congress have been used. Within the coming year the literature relating to Ohio will be rearranged and recatalogued, with numerous additional cross references.

TRAVELING LIBRARIES.

The popularity of the Traveling Library Department continues without abatement. More libraries, larger libraries and better libraries than previously reported have been issued. Following is the record of growth since the organization of the department:

These libraries have gone to 647 communities, ninety-four more than last year. This is an especially encouraging feature of the report, as it indicates a rapidly widening range of circulation.

This report should not close without appreciative reference to the increased appropriations made for the support of the Library at the last

session of the General Assembly. The act authorizing the erection of rooms connecting the two departments had the unanimous support of both Houses and the approval of the Governor. When this improvement is completed it will greatly facilitate the work of the Library.
