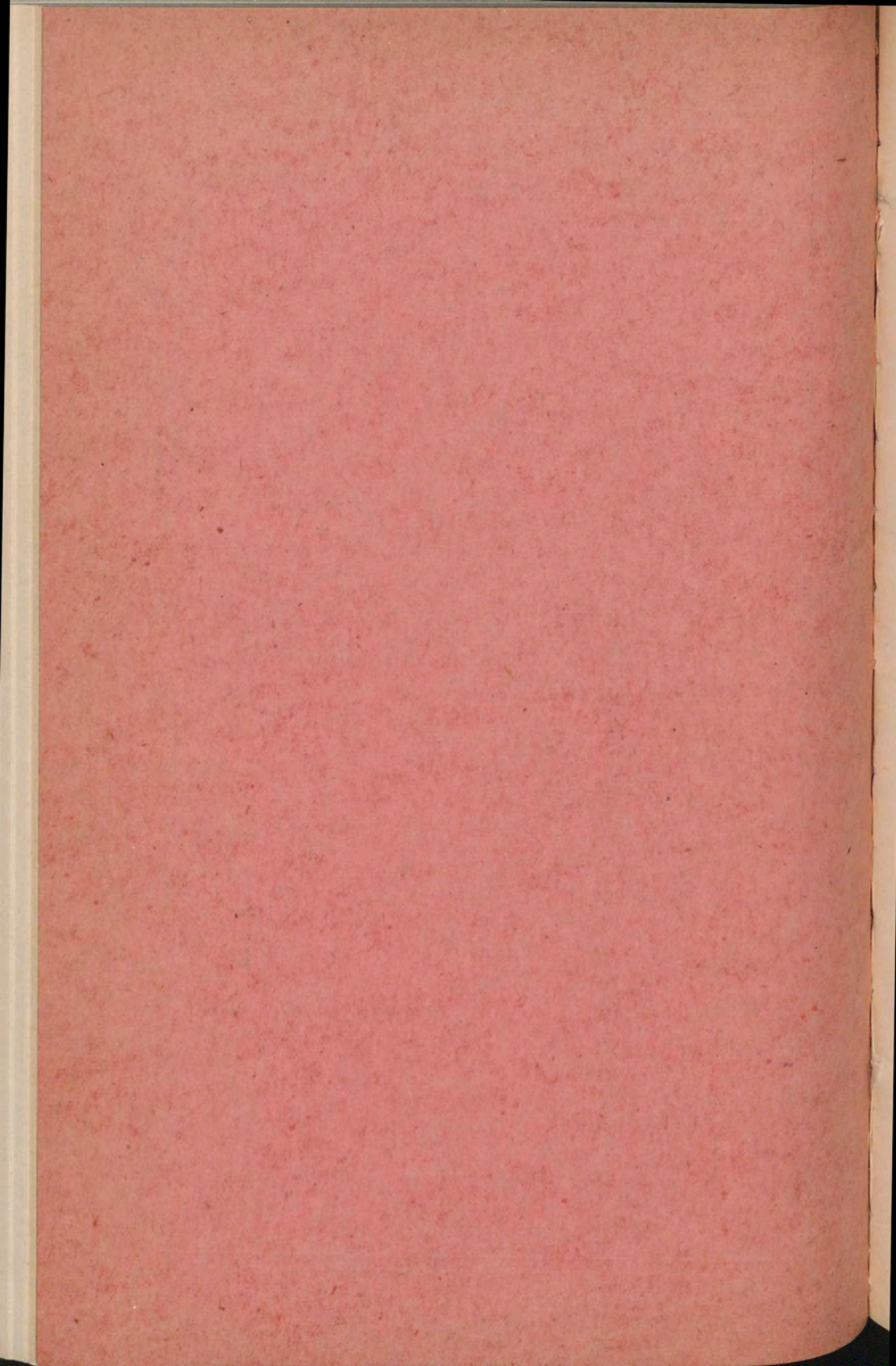

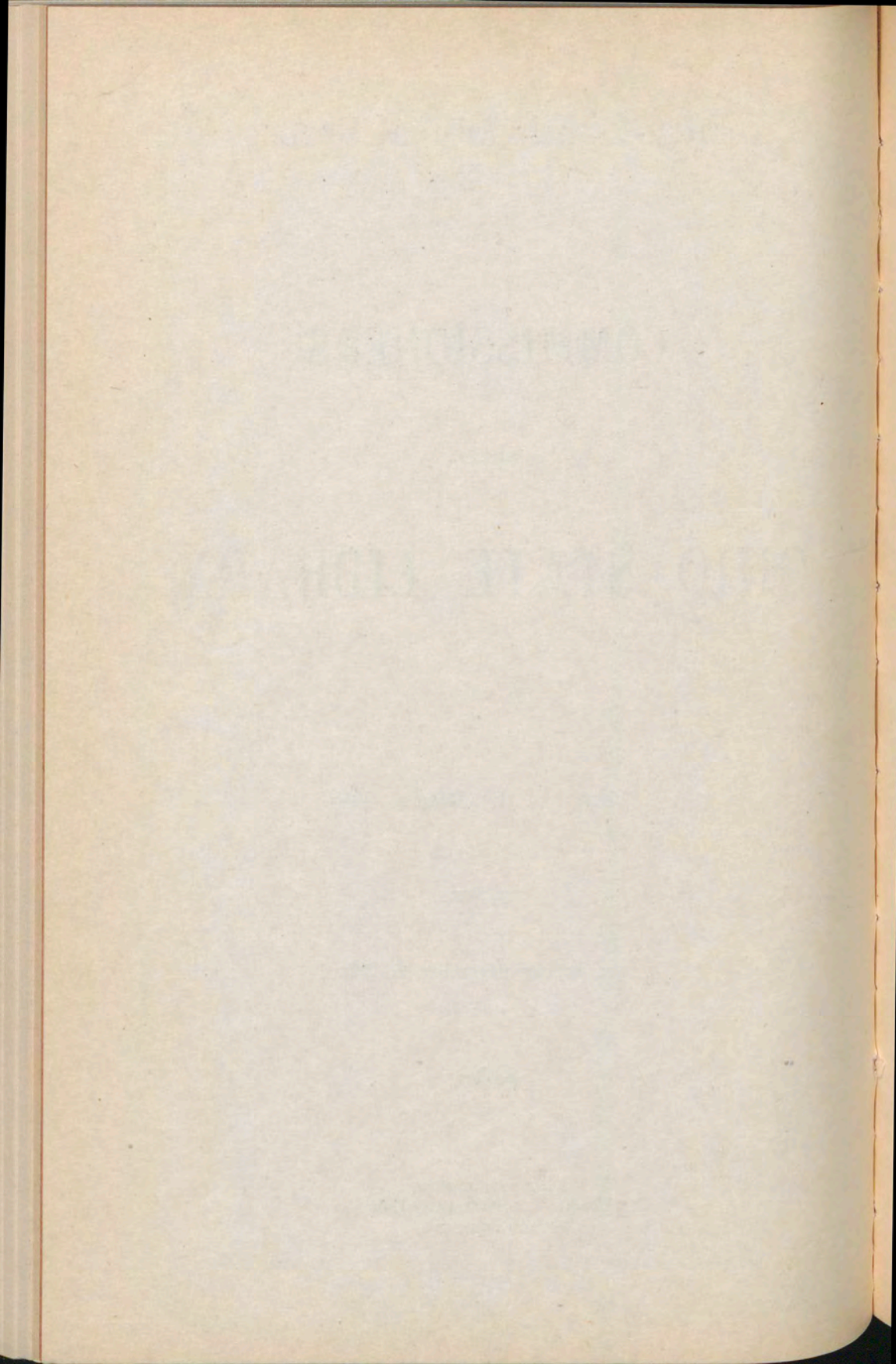

REPORT OF THE BOARD OF LIBRARY COMMISSIONERS.

COLUMBUS, OHIO, November 15, 1903.

To His Excellency, George K. Nash, Governor of Ohio:

SIR:—We have the honor to submit herewith the fifty-eighth annual report of the Board of Library Commissioners, and the eighth report under the library act of 1896.

The report of the Librarian, herewith submitted, shows gratifying progress in the different departments of the State Library. The walls of the main library room have been cleaned and painted; the "old flag and relic rooms" have been thoroughly renovated and partially furnished with shelving; to them the books of the Traveling Library Department, numbering over 25,000 volumes, have been moved; books aggregating more than 8,000 volumes have been added, and the work of the library has been extended to broader fields of usefulness. Since the Library Commission was organized under the act of 1896, there has been no change in the purpose of the Board to strengthen the library with reference to its special mission, and make it more serviceable to the people of Ohio. Today its activities reach every county in the State and its rooms are frequented by students engaged in special research work.

With increased patronage and more efficient service comes the necessity for better financial support. There is now appropriated for the purchase of books in the General Library \$2,500. Pennsylvania expends annually for the same purpose \$3,500, which the librarian of that State in a recent report declares to be utterly inadequate and "far less than the amount received by libraries of states of a sixth of the population of Pennsylvania." Additional means are needed to strengthen the reference department of the Ohio State Library.

The crowded condition of the library is a matter of very serious concern. Hundreds of volumes of newspaper files are now on the floor. State documents are crowded into cases in double ranks, and all available room is occupied. The need of additional space and equipment here is so pressing and apparent that we confidently anticipate adequate provision by the Legislature. This need has become a necessity, and longer delay will most seriously impede the good work of the library.

Many state libraries are collecting, indexing and preserving the archives of their respective states. Ohio, the first State carved out of the Northwest Territory, should have such a department.

The Traveling Library Department, the progress of which it has been our special pleasure to note in former reports, has surpassed all previous records. In spite of the interruptions incident to removal to new quarters, 923 traveling libraries, aggregating 27,078 volumes, have been issued within the year. While a number of other States have much larger appropriations for similar work, Ohio now leads all in the number of traveling libraries issued annually. New York, Wisconsin, Michigan and Pennsylvania each expend a much greater sum annually on their respective traveling library departments, but Ohio reaches more people within the year than any one of them.

In conclusion, we wish especially to commend the Librarian, ever at the post of duty and zealously devoted to his work, and also his assistants who have cordially and faithfully rendered efficient aid. This testimonial is not a perfunctory expression. The Board cheerfully recognizes the fact that a most important service is rendered the State by keeping the administration of the library in safe and competent hands.

STATE LIBRARIAN'S REPORT.

COLUMBUS, OHIO, November 15, 1903.

To the Board of Library Commissioners:

GENTLEMEN:—I have the honor to submit to you the report of the State Library for the year ending November 15, 1903. Within the past year additions have been made as follows:

The number of volumes in the State Library at the close of last year was 81,867. This, with the net increase for the year, makes a total of 90,228 volumes.

Last year the net increase was 6,177 volumes. This year's increase is therefore larger by 1,916 volumes and exceeds by 893 volumes the accessions for any previous year.

The following additions, received within the past year, are worthy of special note:

NEWSPAPERS AND PERIODICALS.

CHILLICOTHE, O.

THE WEEKLY RECORDER, VOLS. 1-6, JULY, 1814—AUG., 1820.—6 v.

Of this paper a writer recently said:

"This is the first religious newspaper in the United States. It was founded by John Andrews, a Presbyterian minister; suspended 1821, but revived in Pittsburg, January, 1822, as Pittsburg Recorder, afterwards styled Presbyterian Banner."

"The Recorder is the first religious weekly in the United States of which files are known to exist; but the distinction of being the first published is claimed for two other journals: (1) Herald of Gospel Liberty, published by Doctor Elias Smith, presumably of Portland, Maine, 1808. (2) Religious Remembrancer, published by John Wellwood Scott, Philadelphia, 1813."

The volumes of this rare paper now in the possession of the State Library, while they lack the first number and a few subsequent issues, are believed to form a file more nearly complete than is to be found in any other library. The Recorder, in addition to religious matter, contains many items of local news. The first volume, covering in part the War of 1812, is especially interesting.

OHIO MONITOR. 1816; 1826-1828; 1829-1833. 3 v. (INCOMPLETE.)

OHIO MONITOR AND PATRON OF INDUSTRY. 1821-1822; 1822-1823. 2 v. (INCOMPLETE.)

This file of the Monitor, though incomplete, is a very valuable addition. The earliest issue found in the collection bears date of June 27, 1816. From August 22d to December 31st, of the same year, there is scarcely a break. This is volume 1 and contains the earliest issues known to be preserved of this pioneer paper.

The Ohio Monitor was founded in 1816 by David Smith and Ezra Griswold. The name was afterwards changed to Ohio Monitor and Patron of Industry. It later became again the Ohio Monitor. In 1835 it was merged into the Western Hemisphere, which in turn became the Ohio Statesman in 1837.

SANDUSKY, OHIO.

SANDUSKY REGISTER. MAY 25, 1851—MAY 25, 1855. 8 v.

This is a substantial addition to the file already in the Library, which begins with June, 1855.

TOLEDO, OHIO.

TOLEDO BLADE. JULY 1857—DEC. 1866; JAN.-DEC. 1873.—19 v.

These volumes of the Blade, covering the war period, are the only file of the paper in the State Library. This is therefore a fortunate acquisition.

TOLEDO, OHIO.

TOLEDO COMMERCIAL. JAN. 1866—DEC. 1876. 18 v.

This, in a measure, supplements the file of the Blade, the two covering a period of twenty years.

THE CULTIVATOR AND COUNTRY GENTLEMAN. 1866-1868. 3 v.

The foregoing agricultural papers were presented to the Library by Dr. E. M. Downs, of Columbus, O.

HARTFORD, CONNECTICUT.

THE CONNECTICUT EVANGELICAL MAGAZINE. VOLS. 1-7. 1800-1807. 7 v.

THE CONNECTICUT EVANGELICAL MAGAZINE AND RELIGIOUS INTELLIGENCER.
VOL. 1. 1808.

These periodicals were forwarded to the State Library on exchange account through the courtesy of Professor Azariah S. Root, librarian of the Oberlin College Library. They contain information relative to the early history of the Western Reserve.

PHILADELPHIA, PA.

THE PORT FOLIO. 1821-1825. 10 v.

The addition of these volumes almost completes the set of this rare periodical extending from 1801-1825. The above volumes were forwarded by the Library of Congress on exchange account.

RICHMOND, VA.

THE SOUTHERN LITERARY MESSENGER. 1835-1859. 29 v.

Arrangements have been made for the purchase of a complete file of this rare magazine, and almost all of the volumes have been delivered.

Some of the foregoing volumes were received too late to be accessioned before the date of this report; hence they do not appear on the following pages.

THE HANSARD DEBATES.

A set of the Hansard Debates, 1800-1892, four hundred and twenty-three volumes, has been added by purchase since our last report. Its value as a reference work is well known. It is the only set to be found in a Columbus library.

SHAKER BOOKS.

Dr. J. P. MacLean, the well-known archæologist and writer, has just presented to the library about thirty pamphlets and volumes of rare Shaker literature. Many of these relate entirely to the history of the Shakers in Ohio. Dr. MacLean's interest in the library is gratefully appreciated.

MANUSCRIPTS.

About four hundred of the Samuel Huntington letters were purchased from Dr. C. E. Rice. For the most part these cover the period of the war of 1812, when Samuel Huntington was district paymaster of the Western army. Among the papers are letters written by Huntington, letters to Huntington, and a number of army muster-rolls. Steps

have been taken to so arrange these manuscripts and others now in the library that they may be the more effectually preserved and more readily accessible. With the present limited facilities this work has necessarily been much delayed.

CONTRIBUTED BY DR. ANDREWS.

An important contribution in the form of forty-one large, closely typewritten pages of manuscript, carefully indexed, has been received from Dr. Andrews, of Marietta College. The introductory note is self-explanatory:

"The following notes were originally made for my own use in studying the early history of Ohio. A copy is left in the State Library for the benefit of other students in the hope that they may also contribute to the same Library copies of private papers which may be of value to the future historian of our State. Persons wishing to see the original of the documents and letters here quoted will apply to the Librarian of Marietta College.

(Signed) MARTIN R. ANDREWS."

This manuscript has been substantially bound and placed on the reference shelves of the library. It is hoped that others engaged in research work, especially that relating to the history of the State, will follow Dr. Andrews' generous example. Thus a most important department will be extended and greatly strengthened. In the absence of the original papers, such material is invaluable.

EXCHANGES OF DUPLICATE MAGAZINES.

For the purpose of aiding in the exchange of duplicate magazines the following circular letter has been sent to many of the libraries of the State:

The Board of Library Commissioners desires to aid in facilitating exchanges of duplicate magazines among the libraries of Ohio. To this end you are requested to report, at your earliest convenience, what duplicates you have in your library.

Please to enter carefully the items on the enclosed blank and mail it to this office. When the returns are in, the lists will be published and mailed to the different libraries of the State. An opportunity will thus be afforded, if the lists of duplicates are as large as anticipated, to make exchanges that will supply many wants.

A few responses have already been received. It is hoped that the lists of duplicates when published may be the means of effecting exchanges mutually advantageous to many libraries.

GENERAL LIBRARY.

The patronage of the reference department has steadily increased. Requests for the loan of books and information as to where material can be found on a given subject reach the library by almost every mail. An effort has been made to meet this new and growing demand.

LIST OF OHIO WRITERS.

A list of Ohio writers is in course of preparation for use in the library. The cards embracing this work so far as filed have already proven helpful. When the list is more nearly complete it will be published.

TRAVELING LIBRARIES.

The feature of the year's work is the very marked increase of the circulation of books through the Traveling Library Department. No stronger testimonial to the popularity of the system can be given than the following record of substantial and steady growth since its organization:

These libraries were sent to 553 different communities of the State.

The foregoing statistics show an increase over last year of 120 libraries, aggregating 5,047 volumes. It is highly gratifying to report that, with a sum of money for this work far less than is appropriated in a number of other states, Ohio distinctly leads in the number of traveling libraries issued and the number of communities reached.

ROOMS ASSIGNED TO TRAVELING LIBRARY
DEPARTMENT.

The Old Flag and Relic Rooms assigned to the State Library, mention of which was made in our last report, have been occupied by the Traveling Library Department. They were thoroughly cleaned and fitted as well as possible with the meager means at the disposal of the Board. While these rooms have afforded temporary relief to the department, they are difficult of access and so poorly heated that it has been found necessary at times to abandon them. They should be furnished with additional shelving and heating apparatus and a room should be built across the court connecting them with the main library.

GREATEST NEED OF THE LIBRARY.

The greatest need of the library is additional room. The number of volumes on its shelves is rapidly approaching 100,000. No other library of similar size in the State, and no State library in any other progressive commonwealth in the Union, is in a more crowded condition. In conclusion, the hope is expressed that the Legislature, which has in times past manifested its appreciation of the work undertaken and carried on by this department, may provide adequately for the apparent needs of the library.
