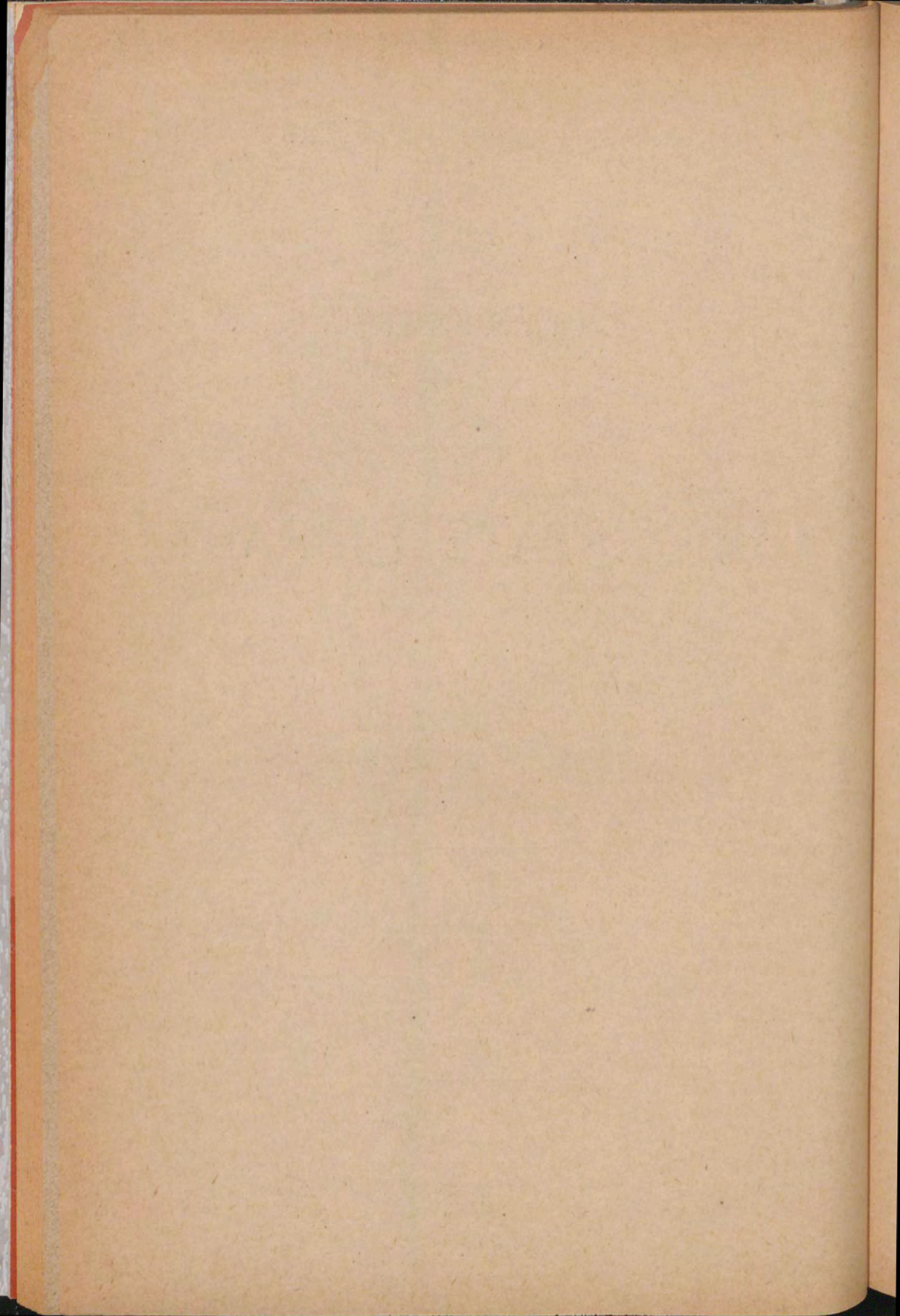

## LIBRARY COMMISSIONERS' REPORT

---

COLUMBUS, OHIO, *November 15, 1893.*

*To the General Assembly of Ohio:*

The Commissioners of the Ohio State Library, in compliance with the requirements of law, herewith present their annual report for the year ending November 15, 1893.

Attention is called to the excellent general condition of the Library, which, in its usefulness to the reading public, was never of greater value in its long history than at the present time. During the past year there have been more visitors to the Library than ever before, and the character of the service has been apparently more generally acceptable than in years past. Much interest has been shown in the purchases of new books, and general commendation has been given the management for the character of the purchases. The usual comment has been that it is easier to procure valuable works of reference now than ever before, and that the Library is of more practical utility to all who seek rare and indispensable works of reference.

Despite the meagre appropriations at the disposal of the Library Commissioners a total of 1,339 volumes was purchased during the year past, a large number of the books consisting of missing bound volumes of valuable illustrated periodicals and magazines which in the lapse of years have become almost impossible to replace and in many instances are worth three or four times their first cost. In this way complete sets of magazines of great value have been procured that in a few years would have been lost forever. The purchases also include about 500 copies of pamphlets some of which are of great historic value. The largest number of bound volumes of leading newspapers have been added to the Library that was ever before secured in a single year. Some 225 books have been received by reason of exchange with other State Libraries, about 150 volumes have been sent by the United States Government, and 32 books of more or less value have been donated to the Library, the total additions being 1,750, and the whole number of volumes registered up to date of this report, 65,400. This is the best showing that has been made for years and is a gain of almost 600 volumes in the total number



of purchases as compared with the preceding year. It is difficult to see how a better use could have been made of the very small appropriations for the purchase of new books.

The general care of the Library has been excellent, and close and zealous attention has been given to the custody of the tens of thousands of books it now contains. A larger number of the vast collection is now on the shelves of the Library than ever before. There are today but few "missing" volumes that can not be accounted for, and diligent search for all still "lost" is being made. The good results of this zealous care of the property of the State are already apparent. The rules regarding the return of books are more strictly observed, and but little disposition is manifested by any visitors to evade or disobey them. More books that were supposed to be lost have been reclaimed and restored to the Library during the past year than for the preceding five years. During the year ending today but four books have been lost or destroyed of the many thousands that have been issued. In each case these losses were either replaced by new books or the missing book paid for.

Of late years some trouble has been experienced by reason of damage done to books by students at the State University, who frequently visit (and are always welcome to) the State Library. The damage has consisted in maliciously cutting from books of translations, and other work of reference, whole chapters or pages needed by the students in the prosecution of their studies. The authorities at the University were prompt to denounce the practice, and by their co-operation the abuse is at an end. No instance of this heedless destruction of books has occurred during the present year while the rules relative to copying have been more cheerfully and carefully observed by the students than ever.

Without any increase of the regular appropriations, as compared with preceding years, a number of permanent and substantial improvements have been made that have long been imperatively necessary. The small rooms above the library proper, in which are stored hundreds of official publications of this and other States, have for years been crowded to what seemed their full capacity. By re-arrangement of the books, however, supplying some additional shelves, and the construction of a large portable case much more shelf room and greater convenience have been secured. Another large case has been built in the Document Room, securing greater facilities and advantages in handling the constantly accumulating store of annual reports and similar official publications. The room heretofore used principally as wash-room has been converted into a second "Newspaper Room," like that on the opposite side of the hall, in which are to be stored the bound volumes of the principal daily newspapers of the country, and of other valuable current publications. This improvement will prove a constant and increasing convenience and benefit.

The main rooms of the Library have been repainted, and other necessary repairs and improvements have been made without increasing



the appropriations or creating a cent's deficiency. It is beleived that the comparatively small amounts at the disposal of the Library Commissioners for repairs, labor, renovation, furniture, supplies and other contingent expenses have been made to go as far as possible. Economy has been considered in every outlay, of whatever character, and care exercised to reduce the running expenses to the lowest limit. In these as in other respects it is believed that the present administration of the Library will compare favorably with that of any of its predecessors.

## RULES OF THE OHIO STATE LIBRARY.

---

### HOURS.

The Ohio State Library is open every day, except Sunday, and the usual legal holidays.

During the session of the Legislature, from nine o'clock A. M. till twelve M.; from two P. M. to five P. M.; and from seven P. M. to nine P. M.

After the adjournment of the Legislature, from nine A. M. till twelve M., and from two to five P. M.

### REGULATIONS.

All persons are permitted to visit the Library, and examine and read the books and magazines.

Those who are entitled to take out books are—

*By law:*

Members and officers and ex-members of the Legislature;

State officers and clerks in the several departments;

The Judges of the Supreme Court, Circuit Court and Courts of Common Pleas;

Superintendents of the benevolent and other State institutions.

*By resolution:*

Resident ministers in the city of Columbus have free use of the Library, in accordance with the rules, who are at the time pastors of congregations, and who apply in person for books for their own use.

The privilege of drawing books from the Library is also extended to the officers and teachers in the benevolent institutions of the State; officers and teachers of the Ohio State University; officers of the Ohio Penitentiary; ex-officers of the State; ex-officers of the General Assembly, and to the widows of deceased ex-members and ex-officers of the General Assembly and ex-State officers.

### RESTRICTIONS.

1. Not more than two books can be taken from the Library by the same person at the same time, and no additional books can be taken out until they are returned.

2. All books taken from the Library must be returned within two weeks, and the same books can not be taken out again by the same person until the expiration of two days thereafter.

3. Rare books of reference, and other volumes of peculiar value, are not intended for circulation, but must be consulted in the Library.



4. Valuable illustrated works can not be taken out, or used or handled, for mere amusement.

5. No person is allowed to take any book from any alcove, or *table*, without permission, and no book can be taken from the Library without a memorandum thereof upon the record by the Librarian or Assistant.

6. Persons returning books to the Library must report the same to the Librarian or Assistant, who shall cancel them upon the record.

7. Persons who lose books or permit them to be damaged while in their possession, must pay for, or replace them.

8. Copying from books in the Library must be done with pencil; leaves must not be turned down, and no marks of any kind made on the margins.

9. Any person having the legal right to take books from the Library, who shall give an order for, or furnish books to any person not having such right, to be used by such person, shall thereby forfeit his or her own privilege.

10. Members and officers of the General Assembly shall return all books in their possession four days before the adjournment of the session; and it shall be the duty of the Librarian to report to the Senate or House of Representatives, the names of any officers or members who fail to comply with the foregoing requirement.

11. Loud talking and smoking in the Library are strictly forbidden.
