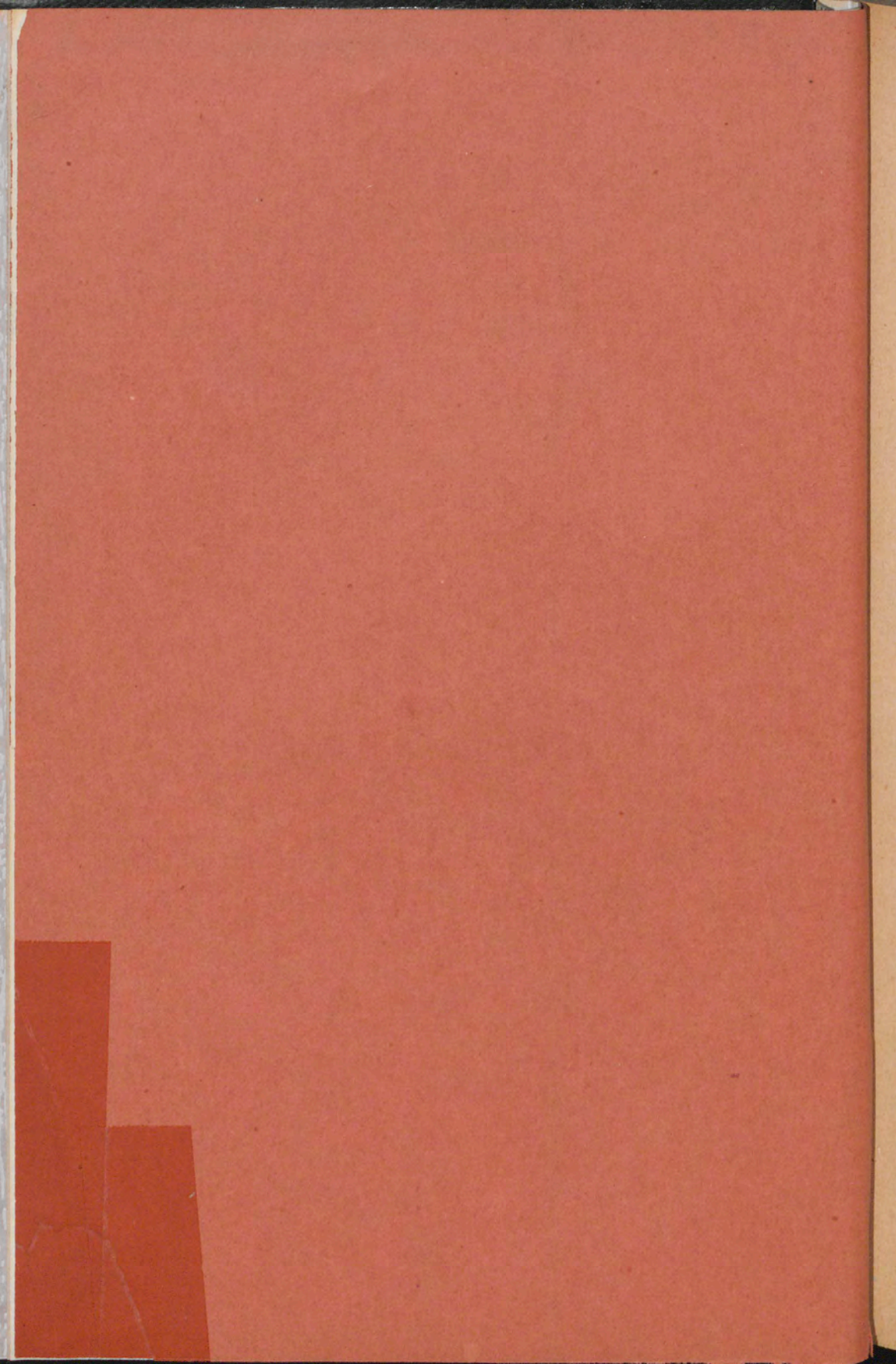

## IN MEMORIAM.

John C. Tuthill, born at Lancaster, Ohio, March 17, 1841; appointed State Librarian, February 19, 1890; died at Lancaster, O., May 18, 1892.

A meeting of the State officials was held at the Governor's office on Thursday afternoon, May 19th, for formal action relative to the death of Hon. John C. Tuthill, State Librarian. At this meeting Governor McKinley presided, and the following resolutions were adopted:

WHEREAS, Death has again invaded the ranks of those serving the State officially, and taken therefrom our associate, John C. Tuthill, State Librarian; therefore,

*Resolved,* That in his death the State has lost a valued and intelligent official, and an upright and honest citizen.

*Resolved,* That we extend to the bereaved family our heartfelt sympathy in their hour of affliction, and an assurance of sincere participation in their sorrow.

*Resolved,* That we attend his funeral in a body.

*Resolved,* That as a tribute to his memory this action and these resolutions be presented to the Board of Library Commissioners for record upon their minutes, and that an engrossed copy thereof be delivered to the family of the deceased.
