LIBRARY COMMISSIONERS REPORT—1882.

COLUMBUS, OHIO, *December 30, 1882.*

To the General Assembly of the State of Ohio :

In accordance with the requirements of law, the Commissioners of the State Library report. We believe the Library has never been in a better condition than now. It is clean, books all carefully arranged, and visitors are well accommodated. The appropriation of last winter has enabled us to greatly brighten and beautify the room. We recommend an appropriation for new furniture, and if a new carpet were furnished in addition, our State Library would equal, if not excel, any State Library in the Union.

The catalogue of books was published in 1875. Since then thousands of volumes have been entered, and a supplemental catalogue has been made, and compiled by Miss Harbaugh. She has done so with accuracy and care. The Library, since the catalogue of 1875, has had a card catalogue, alphabetically arranged, of every purchase, gift or exchange ; these slips were pasted on sheets of paper to aid the publisher ; the title and location of the books were contained on the slips.

In the discharge of her official duties Miss Harbaugh has performed promptly and well, and the Librarian is glad to say that he was so situated as to enable her, with his cordial approval, to be absent for recreation, enjoyment or health, whenever she desired.

We have purchased a number of books, but in so doing the Librarian has consulted men of culture and learning, and has endeavored to do the best he could for the State.

The Library is now well ventilated, and the atmosphere therein pure.

We submit the following proposition from an electrician, and hope it will be accepted :

Hon. Jos. H. Geiger, State Librarian :

DEAR SIR: I will put one hundred and sixteen porcelain electric burners (as per sample), put in a two-pound switch to light upper and lower tier of lights, and do the necessary gas-fitting to bring gas-pipe and stop-cock for the upper tier of lights down alongside electrical machine, for the sum of one hundred and twenty-

five (\$125) dollars, and keep same in practical working order for one year, free of expense to the State.
