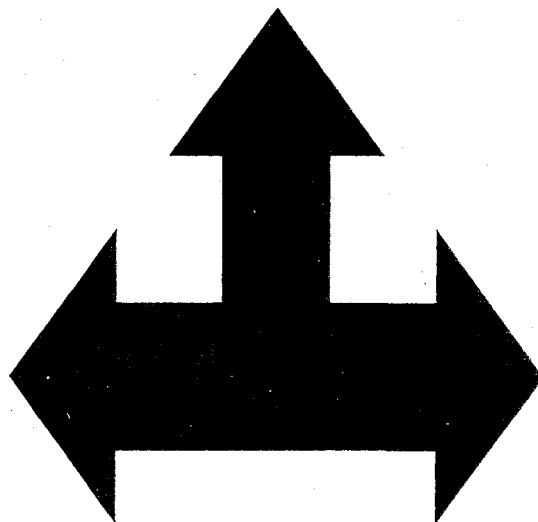
# Alma Clawsey

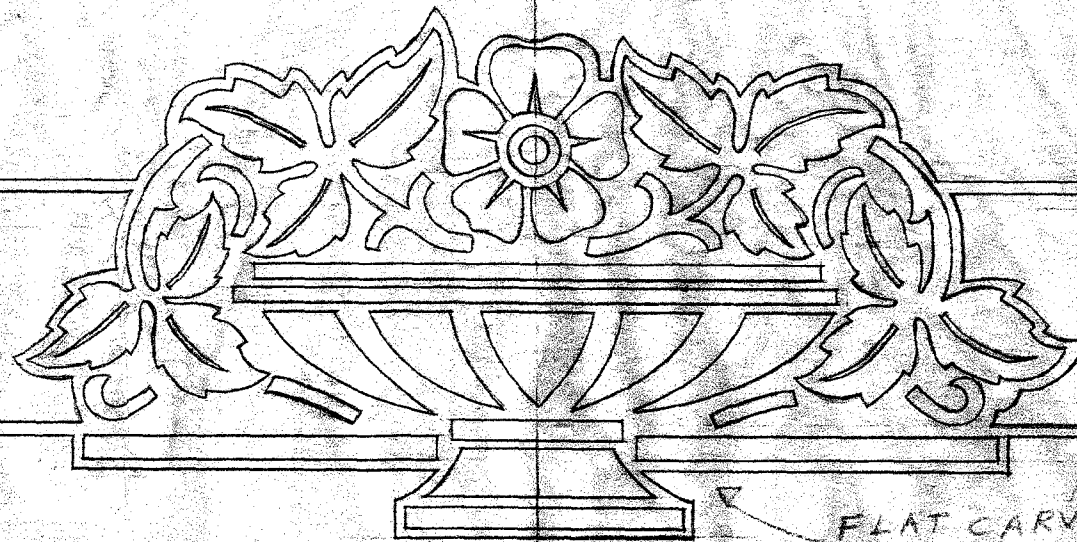
